Dear friends,

In this year of jubilee (20 years) MAA launches a campaign to reconstruct the clitoris of Maasai women, victims of mutilation and this at their request.

We want to help 5 victims of FGM, rural and very poor women, to regain their femininity.

The story:

In February 2024, the president, Annie, met with them in Kenya (see film: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ehHUikpgxIY&t=38s>)

In the discussion, it was brought to their attention the reconstruction and repair of the ravages of cutting. In Nairobi, at the private Karen Hospital, the gynaecologist Dr. Abullahi Adan operates on mutilated Kenyan women for about \$700 per case.



In addition to the gift that we will offer these rural women, victims of the cruel tradition that MAA has been fighting for 20 years, it is a question of creating a «snowball effect» for our campaign against FGM.

Indeed, if rural women find out and demand reparation for the harm done to them at the age of young adolescents, surely they will turn their backs on this cruel practice.

When the news spreads in the countryside, no woman will want to impose it on her daughter because going back is so expensive and unlikely. If married women are so desperate to repair their cut body, why impose it on young girls whose bodies are still whole?
